Karnataka Cong leaders meet Guv, demand cancellation of MLC T Narayanaswamy's membership

Bengaluru, Sep 3: Days after the Karnataka governor Thawar Chand Gehlot sought clarification from the state government over the alleged illegal land allotment against Congress chief Mallikarjun Kharge's family and the Siddaramaiah government, on September 3, chief whip Saleem Ahmad, along with Karnataka Pradesh Congress Committee (KPCC) working presidents and MLCs Manjunath Bhandary and Vasanth Kumar, led a delegation to meet the Governor of Karnataka and demanded for the cancellation of membership of MLC T Narayanaswamy.

They raised concerns about the alleged misuse of a plot allotted to T Narayanaswamy, leader of the opposition in the Karnataka Legislative Council. The delegation accused Narayanaswamy of misusing the plot, providing false information to the Karnataka Housing Board, and illegally acquiring a CA site. They urged



the Governor to cancel Narayanaswamy's membership in the Legislative Council. MLAs Puttanna, Narayanaswamy, Dinesh Gooligowda, and several other legislators were present.

Rising cases prompt Karnataka govt to declare dengue an epidemic

Bengaluru, Sep 4: The number of dengue cases is rising across the state, prompting the Karnataka government to officially declare dengue as an epidemic. The government has issued a gazette notification, amending the Karnataka Epidemic Diseases Act, 2020, to classify dengue as an epidemic. This notification is applicable statewide and includes stringent measures to control dengue and other mosquito-borne diseases.

According to the new rules, all property owners, builders, and those responsible for any premises—including land, buildings, water tanks, gardens, and playgrounds—are required to take necessary steps to prevent mosquito breeding. It is mandatory to ensure that water storage containers, sumps, and overhead tanks are covered. Solid waste must be disposed of properly, and items that can collect water, such as empty containers, cans, unused tires, and other objects, must be removed. The state government has made it



compulsory to manage unused tanks, pits, or any other water-stagnation areas to prevent mosquito breeding. The amendment will give the competent authority, including the BBMP chief commissioner in Bengaluru and district commissioners in other areas, the power to inspect properties, issue notices, and enforce compliance with the regulations.

Officials of this authority can conduct inspections at any time during the day, with prior notice. Property owners or those responsible can be directed to take immediate action to eliminate mosquito breeding through physical, chemical, or biological meth-

ods. If the individual fails to comply within the specified time, authorities are empowered to take the necessary steps themselves. Fines will be imposed for non-compliance based on the type of property and location. Urban households will face a fine of Rs 400, while rural households will be fined Rs 200 for non-compliance. Commercial establishments such as offices, schools, colleges, health facilities, hotels, and other places in urban areas will be fined Rs 1,000, while those in rural areas will be fined Rs 500. Active or abandoned construction sites and vacant lots in urban areas will incur a fine of Rs 2,000, and

in rural areas, Rs 1,000. These fines will be enforced in areas under the jurisdiction of BBMP and Mangaluru City Corporation. Additionally, if negligence continues after a notice is issued, an additional fee of 50% of the total fine amount will be levied for each subsequent week of violation. The responsibility of imposing and collecting these fines lies with the authority or its designated officers to ensure strict adherence to the regulations and to curb the spread of dengue in Karnataka. Dengue symptoms include high fever, severe headache, joint and muscle pain, rash, and sometimes bleeding and vomiting.

Konkan Railway to run 310 special trains during Ganesh Chaturthi festival season

Udupi, Sep 4: To accommodate the increased passenger traffic, Konkan Railway will operate 310 special train trips in coordination with Central Railway, Western Railway, and Southern Railway during the Ganesh Chaturthi festival season.

These special trains will run from Udhna, Vishvamitri, Surat, Ahmedabad, Mumbai Central, Mumbai CSMT, Lokmanya Tilak (T), Bandra, and Panvel to Ratnagiri, Kudal, Sawantwadi Road, Madgaon, Surathkal, Thokur, and Mangaluru.

Arrangements have been made to ensure the safety and comfort of passengers.

Herbal formulations can help control blood sugar levels



New Delhi: With the surge in diabetes cases, a study has suggested a healthy lifestyle and diet coupled with anti-diabetic properties of herbal formulations can help control blood sugar levels. The study, conducted by researchers from Patna-based Government Ayurvedic College and Hospital on a patient suffering from high levels of blood sugar, has been published in the International Ayurvedic Medical Journal (IAMJ). As per the study, the team, led by

Assistant Professor Prabhas Chandra Pathak, prescribed the patient a combination of research-based traditional medicines, including herbal formulation like BGR-34, Arogyavardhani Vati, Chandraprabhavati, cholesterol reducing drugs, lifestyle adjustments and a specific diet for two weeks. Encouraged by the positive results of the treatment plan, the researchers have suggested a comprehensive larger study for its further assessment.

In fact, earlier a study by the AIIMS Delhi found that BGR-34 is effective not only in reducing sugar but obesity as well. Sanchit Sharma, Executive Director, Aimil Pharmaceuticals, said since diabetic patients have to depend on lifetime medicines, the outcome of the study holds significance. "These herbal preparations also have elements to increase immunity as well as anti-oxidants levels," he added. After 14 days, the treatment was slightly altered.

The patient showed significant improvement, for instance, the sugar level which was 254 mg/dl at the time of admission, came down to 124 mg/dl. The study says it was found that Daruharidra, Giloe, Vijaysar, Gudmar, Methi and Majishtha in the BGR-34 showed anti-diabetic properties, which helped cut down the sugar level in the blood. This medicine is prepared by the country's research institute, CSIR, after research. Owing to a sedentary lifestyle and unhealthy dietary habits, diabetes is on increase in the country. As per latest data, there are 72.9 million people suffering with diabetes in India. Researchers said that during the study, patient was also recommended an hour's walk daily. The patient's fasting sugar level, which was 254 mg/dl before the start of treatment, came down to 124 mg/dl. Similarly, the sugar level after breakfast decreased from 413 to 154 mg/dl. All these parameters indicate effective reduction in blood sugar level.

Encouraged by the positive results of the treatment plan, the researchers have suggested a comprehensive larger study for its further assessment. In fact, earlier a study by the AIIMS Delhi found that BGR-34 is effective not only in reducing sugar but obesity as well. Sanchit Sharma, Executive Director, Aimil Pharmaceuticals, said since diabetic patients have to depend on lifetime medicines, the outcome of the study holds significance. "These herbal preparations also have elements to increase immunity as well as anti-oxidants levels," he added.
